Sewing accessories last a very long time and will undergo alot of use depending, of course, on how much sewing will be done.

STUDENT MUST PURCHASE AND BRING SEWING MACHINE TO ALL VIRTUAL SESSIONS: Sewing Machine with all of the accessories provided at time of purchase. The sewing machine's manual is mandatory since it is a very important and useful reference.
